Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop hiring only 4 individuals. Overall sales for that initial year totaled \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and various components. Through 5 years of operation, the business had expanded to 40 staff and their annual sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Now, Cascade is among the top international makers within the material handling trade.

Production and design of the company's original hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business possibilities. During the past 60 years, the material handling industry has grown into a highly complex area and Cascade has proudly performed a part on this growth. Cascade at present continues to grow as the leader supplier of lift truck accessories and different associated products. The company feels assured in their ability to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive in the global market.

In the 1950's, Cascade started designing, manufacturing and selling hydraulic attachments. Manufacturing was finished in the year 1956 on a new office so as to house all plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present center of operations. Subsequent to 15 years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached practically \$2,300,000.

A second manufacturing plant was built in the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary transfer into the global world of the material handling industry when the company established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in the year 1965, the business went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Since then the business has expanded its manufacturing facilities throughout the continental USA to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade merchandise are made internationally because of numerous subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This facility is designed to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and the year 1997 subsequent to buying five companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the global leader in forks.
